Small mammal trapping in Gutter Bridge Wood, Swaffham Bulbeck, from 1 September to 2 September 2018 – Peter Pilbeam and Joy Dingley.

Twenty (20) Longworth traps were set up with bedding (hay) and bait (nut and fruit muesli, diced apple and casters - all in excess) along the sides of the near-circular path round the wood from about 6pm on 1 September 2018. They were checked from 8am on 2 September 2018. The captured animals were sexed and weighed and released immediately where caught. One animal was marked by fur clip to demonstrate the technique. The traps were then removed.

Overnight the weather was dry, warm and cloud-free.

Conclusions:

Over the 20 trap nights a total of 14 captures were made – 5x Wood Mouse, 6x Bank Vole, 1x Yellow Necked Mouse and 2x Common Shrew (the one in trap 55 was possibly a Pygmy Shrew).

The Yellow Necked Mouse was a juvenile. The definite Common Shrew in trap 71 had white-tipped ears. Trap 52 had two Bank Vole - unusual in itself - the one weighing 27gm was a lactating female. The Bank Vole in trap 63 was also a lactating female.
