## Small mammal trapping. Paxton Pits Nature Reserve. 1st-2nd July 2022 George Baber


The weather on both days was fine, dry and sunny.

## **Longworth Traps**

Twenty (20) Longworth traps were set up with bedding (hay) and bait (muesli, diced apple, and casters) at various locations in an area known as the 'Sanctury') (map reference: TL20216364) from 7.30pm on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022. They were checked and opened from 8.00am on the following day and then removed from the site. Animals found in traps were identified for species, weighed, and sexed.
